What have we been learning?

Reading: In Reading, we will be moving onto learning about biographies. Students will be reading about important people from the past and present that have made significant contributions to our world. We will also be learning about facts and opinions through these biographies.

Math: In math, we are learning unit fractions such as halves, fourths, eighths, thirds and sixths. Students will be decomposing parts of a whole to identify these unit fractions. At the end of the week students will be starting to identify equivalent fractions.

Writing: In writing, we will be starting our biography writing projects. This week students will choose a person to research. Once they have chosen this person they will begin to take notes on an outline. The next step is using the outline to create a rough draft, then edit, revise, and publish a final copy.

Science/Social Studies: In Social Studies, students will be working on creating their “Regions of North Carolina” brochure. They must be able to identify human and physical characteristics of the land along with some unique activities that you can do in each region.
