3rd Grade Newsletter

What have we been learning?

Reading: In reading, we have been looking at an nonfiction article about the threat to seals. Students are learning about the different types of seals, dangers facing seals, and learning ways to protect them. We have been using skills such as point of view, comparing and contrast, main idea, and text features.

Math: In math, we have moved onto our unit on measurement. This week students will be looking at capacity-liters, mass-grams, length-inches and deciding what unit they should use in different situations. We will also be talking about the different tools used to measure these units.

Writing: In writing, we have been researching polar bears for our class book. Each group is responsible for gathering information on a different topic of polar bears. After each group compiles their information they are working on writing an introduction and 2 paragraphs about their topic. After drafting, revising, and editing, we will put all of our writing together to create a classbook.

Science/Social Studies: In science, we will continue to learn about the phases of matter. Students will look at mixtures this week focusing on solid mixtures and mixtures using liquids.
