


3rdGrade Newsletter

Reading: Third Graders we have been reading books from a series. Students are working on comparing and contrasting themes from series books and using evidence to support the similarities and differences. We will also be discussing literal and nonliteral language using various books.





On Tuesday, we will be dissecting owl pellets to compare rodent bones to human bones. We will also learn about the function of joints.
