What have we been learning?

Reading: In reading we will continue to read books from a series. Students have been comparing books to see how the characters, setting, and plot are similar or different. We are also learning about literal and non-literal language. Students will identify idioms, similes, and metaphors this week.



Math: In math we have continued to practice multiplication facts through one minute timed test. Last week we worked on multiplying and dividing by 3 and 4. We also created multiplication and division word problems. This week we will be multiplying and dividing by 0 and 1 and also identifying properties of operations when multiplying and dividing.

Writing: In writing we are working on researching and taking notes for their organization. Students will then use their notes to create a tree diagram. This will help them organize their information into branches and lefty details.

Science/Social Studies: In Science, we have been learning about the movement of our joints. Students identified parts of the body that have hinge joints, ball and socket joints, and gliding joints. This week students will be learning about the function of our muscular system.
