What have we been learning?

Reading: In reading, we are learning about similes and metaphors. We have been locating them in the books we are reading, and will be writing our own. In guided reading, we are finishing our "books in a series" then we will be moving on to nonfiction texts.

Math: In math, we continuing to practice our multiplication and division. We have been solving two step problems and finding the unknown. This week we will be talking about square numbers (4x4) (2x2) and how to solve mixed word problems using multiplication, division, addition and subtraction.

Writing: In writing, we are finishing up our opinion letters. Our topic was which piece of equipment would you add to the playground? Students are in the final steps of the writing process. Next week we will be starting a new writing project. Details to come soon!
