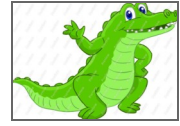




3rdGrade Newsletter



What have we been learning?

Reading: In reading, we are looking at nonfiction texts and identifying text features such as bold words, titles, headings, glossaries, index, diagrams, pictures and captions.

Math: In math, we worked hard last week to solve word problems using different operations. We learned clue words to help us when solving these problems and even wrote some of our own! This week we will be moving on to solving two step problems using addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.

Writing: In writing, we will continue writing opinion/research pieces. Students have chosen an organization to support (St Judes, Make a Wish, Ronald McDonald, Caged Bird Society, Wake County Animal Shelter, American Heart Association). They will be researching their organization, and writing a paper trying to convince other students to donate to their charity.

Science/Social Studies: In Science, we are finishing up our human body unit with a research project. Students will be creating Prezis about an area of the body we studied (skin, joints, muscles, skeleton). Students will research questions to gather information for their presentation to display the information they have learned.
