What have we been learning?


Reading: In reading this week we will be making and answering questions about timelines. Students will be asked to create a sequence of events and create cause and effect relationships using timelines. In guided reading, students will be reading recipes and directions and answering how to type questions.

Math: In math, we are moving on to our area and perimeter unit. Students will be exploring area and perimeter by counting square units and explaining attributes of plane figures.

Writing: In writing, students will be working on nonfiction writing of an area of their choice until the end of the quarter.
