What have we been learning?

Reading: In reading, we have started our mystery unit by learning mystery vocabulary. We have read several mystery picture books while looking at elements of mysteries. In guiding reading this week we will start to explore more mysteries as we dig into the genre.

Math: In math, we are learning how to figure out area and perimeter of regular and irregular shapes. We started by counting square units and are now using formulas. This week we will be solving word problems using both perimeter and areas.

Writing: In writing, we have started with suspense stories. Students have begun by mapping out hints to solving the mystery of what is out in the woods. We have starting writing an introduction to our stories and will finish this week by drafting out 3 hints.

Science/Social Studies: In science, we have started our unit entitled "Objects in the Sky". This week students will be looking at the movement of the moon around the earth.
