What have we been learning?

Reading: Third graders have been learning about different types of questions; in the book and in my head. We have been coming up with questions that are right there, think and search, author and me and on my own. This week students will be using what they learned last week to identify these types of questions when they are asked within a text.

Math: Third graders have been working on adding and subtracting 2 and 3 digit numbers. Please have them review basic addition and subtraction facts. This will help them to solve more difficult problems. This week we will be working on subtraction across zeros and relating subtraction and addition. Students will also work on solving word problems using these skills.

Writing: Third graders will be working on drafting and revising the personal narrative they are going to publish about their summer vacation. We will learn revising techniques such as exciting beginning and endings, writing in chronological order, and how to conference with a peer or teacher.

Science/Social Studies: In science, we have started our plant unit. Last week we studied parts of a seed. Students looked at both dry and wet beans and made observations of each bean. We have also planted our Wisconsin Fast Plants. We are eagerly awaiting the growth of these plants. This week we will be learning about composing.
