What have we been learning?

Reading: In reading we have finished up our types of questions unit (right there, think and search, author and me and on my own). Students will now be learning about folk literature. We will be concentrating on characteristics of myths, legends, fairy takes, folktales, legends.

Math: We have finished working on addition and subtraction and are now moving into learning about rounding. Students will be using place value to understand how to round whole numbers to the nearest 10 or 100.

Writing: Third graders have been working hard to revise, edit, and publish their personal narratives. The students are all working on different parts of the writing process to finish their papers. Ask your child to share their personal narrative with you!

Science: We have been continuing to watch our plants grow. Students have been observing their plant by measuring the growth and recording observations of changes every few days. We have also discussed the life cycle of a plant and the important functions each part of the plant provides. This week we will be learning about how bees and plants work together.
