Sept. 13th Word Study

What have we been learning?

Reading: Third graders will be learning about character traits. This week each of the students will receive a trait and will perform a skit with a group portraying that trait. Later in the week students will be looking at characters from well known books by examining their character traits.

Math: Third graders have started geometry. Last week we started by learning parallel, intersecting, and perpendicular lines. We also identified line segments, end points, and lines. This week we will start by looking at different quadrilaterals. Ask your child to identify some of the vocabulary we learned last week around your house or neighborhood.

Writing: Third graders will be learning about how to use quotation marks in their writing. We will use the rules to incorporate dialogue into our imaginative narratives.

Science/Social Studies: We will begin our social studies unit about government. This week we will start by learning about the rights and responsibilities of citizens. We will also learn about the 3 branches of government and focus on local government.
