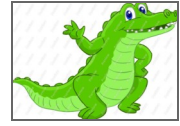




3rdGrade Newsletter



What have we been learning?

Reading: Third Graders finished up last week learning about point of view. This week we will be learning about context clues. In guided reading we have started to read our first book in a series. Students are applying all skills learned in the past two weeks into their discussions of their chapter book.

Math: Third Graders have finished our unit on geometry. We created geo-cities labeling parallel, perpendicular, and interesting streets, along with adding different types of polygons and quadrilaterals. This week we are moving on to understanding patterns in multiplication and division. Ask your child what patterns they can recall from the week.

Writing: Third Graders have been working on learning how to add elaboration to our writing. This week we will be working on finishing our imaginative narrative drafts, revising, and editing. We can't wait to share all of our hard work with you!

Science/Social Studies: Students will be learning about citizenship. We will be identifying citizens rights, responsibilities, and duties along with their contributions to their community. Students will take their government test next Wednesday
